

## Brief Description of the Project

Volunteer service gives young people amazing chances to have amazing experiences in their daily lives, and in the process they learn many new skills. However, all of the skills acquired through volunteering are not properly recognized. Developing skills through volunteering is useful for increasing employment and it can contribute to the personal development of volunteers, but unfortunately, this opportunity is hardly used.

When managed properly, volunteering is a win for all stakeholders, including:

- Volunteers gain soft and hard skills that increase their confidence and qualifications for the job market;
- Non-governmental organizations gain support and additional accomplishments that would not have been possible without
- volunteers' dedication;
- And the local community benefits in a variety of ways related to the specific activities undertaken by the volunteer.

## Goals and Methods

This training course will meet real demands and emphasize EU values, Erasmus+ program priorities, and build skills and methods of professional development for youth workers and volunteers of partner organizations. Moreover, this method involves working with young people digitally, which is very important for transmitting common basic values of society to hard-to-reach groups of young people. Furthermore, we also want to prevent radicalization among young people.

The main goals of the "YW Ambassadors" training course are:

- To introduce project partners' approaches to volunteering in the context of their work.
- To contribute to the development of personal and organizational abilities in the design, production, mentoring, and evaluation of regional,
- national, and worldwide volunteer projects.
- Create organizational outreach to include youth in volunteering schemes.
- Strengthen the organizational calendar and strategies for making progress in volunteer schemes that require a diverse approach.

## Profile of participants

Participants are expected to be youth workers, with decision-making capacity and involved in the local and international activities of their organizations sending partners - having an active participation in the preparation phase of this Training Course. They must have experience in working with young people with fewer opportunities, in the use of non-formal education methodologies and in project management, also linked to the topic of the project; they must be motivated to contribute in all phases of the project, to disseminate the results and to stimulate activities with young people, finally, be aware and recognize the problems, needs and expectations of the project and of young Europeans and what opportunities (also for personal / social transformation of their reality) can be used as an answer.

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## Accommodation

#### How to get to the venue

If you are traveling with your team, the most convenient way to get from Riga Airport to Riga Central Station is the **YANDEX GO** app - this taxi app provides cheap services. Even if you split the cost for two (to the center of Riga it will be about € 7-10). Here's what the app looks like:

Since, unfortunately, according to Erasmus+ rules, we cannot reimburse taxi, we highly recommend using this option with a promo code.



#### MORE ABOUT FREE RIDES AND DISCOUNTS

YANDEX GO will take you from Riga Airport to the project venue for about 30-35 EUR. Use promo code UHAG8RIC and get a discount from the first trip. This means that the trip will cost you less. It will also save a lot of your time due to not having to wait for the bus/train/pickup. If you have a group of 3 or 4 people, it might make sense, You are welcome:)

# How to get to the venue with public transport

Take bus or minibus 22 from Riga Airport to the city center and get off at the "Autoosta" stop.

Ticket price: 2 EUR / person

From the bus stop "Autoosta" walk about 4 minutes (260 m) to the Central Railway Station "ORIGO".

At the station you buy a ticket to **Saulkrasti**. Trains run every hour, so you do not have to wait long. And the travel time will be about 1 hour.

**Attention:** Let us know when you depart, so that we are ready to pick you up from the Saulkrasti train station and take you to the project venue.



## Travel Reimbursement


International travel expenses can be reimbursed **ONLY** upon presentation of **ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS** stating your travel information and costs, namely:

- 1. Boarding passes (For round trip),
- 2. Tickets (Also e-tickets),
- 3. Receipts (In case the tickets are bought by cash),
- 4. Invoices and card payment history (In case the tickets are bought by bank card),
- 5. Payment checks / Bank statements.

Participants are requested to bring with them all mentioned documents, likewise, any other payment bills, checks, tickets and payment prove that they will get during the travel. Regarding way-back tickets and boarding passes, they should be sent by <u>international post service</u> to "CoSE" in Belgium (example: check-in at airport) or by e-mail (if they were issued through online check-in). **SCANS / PHOTOS / SCREENSHOTS ARE NOT ALLOWED!!!** 

Because of Erasmus+ rules, unfortunately we cannot reimburse Taxi costs.

Reimbursement for ALL COUNTRIES will be done by BANK TRANSFER after we have all original tickets and relevant documents.
