Youth exchange - Castellammare di Stabia (Italy) 25 April - 03 May 2022





Recent surveys in Europe show that almost half of young people would prefer to work as self-employed rather than as an employee (European Commission, 2018). However, very few young people work as self-employed. In 2018, only 6.5% of young people in employment between 20 and 29 were self-employed in the EU. One of the biggest political

challenges of the last decade for many Member States has been the youth unemployment crisis. In the EU, the youth unemployment rate peaked in 2013 at 23.7%, but reached much higher levels in several Member States. Furthermore, the gender gap also appears significantly among young self-employed workers.

Once you arrive in Naples:

- From Napoli Central Station (Napoli Garibaldi) take the train "CIRCUMVESUVIANA" direction to Sorrento: your stop will be "Via Nocera". From there is 2 minutes walking to the hotel. # **HEALTH INSURANCE & COVII**

Health insurance is not provided and will not be reimbursed by the organizers. All participants are strongly advised to purchase private travel insurance or/and to have a valid **EUROPEAN INSURANCE CARD**.

We strongly remind you that:

- if you test positive for Covid before traveling to Italy and you will not be able to travel, we will not be able to refund your travel to and from Italy;
- if you test positive during your stay in Italy, at the end of the project we will not be able to provide accommodation and food for the quarantine if you have to do it;
- if you wish to carry out a PCR or antigen before, during or after your trip to Italy, remember that it will not be reimbursed by the program;

- if you wish (and we recommend it) you can take out any insurance that covers any costs due to Covid, but even this will not be reimbursed by the program;

IMPORTANT: Due to covid restrictions, the Hotel will only accept guests with double dose vaccine less than 6 months or third dose (BOOSTER).



# REIMBURSEMENT

Participant's travel costs from their home city to Castellammare di Stabia - Italy, will be reimbursed on actual expenses of the participants and also according to distance calculator of Erasmus+ program.

The planned travel reimbursement maximum limits are based on calculated distance of official registration address of the sending organizations from the partner countries to the project venue Castellammare di Stabia, Italy based on the Erasmus + program distance calculator <a href="http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance\_en.htm">http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance\_en.htm</a> (please note that the distance is calculated one-way, but the reimbursement amounts are for return travel).

We kindly ask all participants to take the most environmentally friendly and cost effective alternative available.

#### **Travel Reimbursement Rules**

- 1) Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of all (including return tickets) original tickets, receipts/invoices and boarding passes. Please remember to bring the original invoice. There will be no reimbursement without the original invoices and tickets with indicated Names of travelers, description of the journey, indication of cost and currency and date of travel.
- 2) Reimbursement will be done in EURO based on the actual price of the tickets indicated on the ticket or/and receipt/invoice. This will be very helpful for the organizers to begin processing the financial and reimbursement data so that all payments may be made as efficiently as possible.
- 4) We STRONGLY advise you that we're not able to reimburse private transport (for example taxi etc.).
- **5)** Please, try to buy all the tickets you can online and send us by email, so we will be faster to calculate total amount for each participant and reimburse everybody on the spot.

**6)** Please note that additional services on your bookings won't be reimbursed (extra leg room in the place, additional luggage etc).
