. Subject of exchange:

- 1. Ecological urban space ways of planning urban space taking into account the principles of sustainable development.
- 2. Intercultural education 6 cultural evenings as part of the project. Participants from Poland, Turkey, Spain, Lithuania, Greece and Slovakia will present their traditions, national specialties and curiosities in turn.

Young people will learn how to plan urban space taking into account the principles of sustainable development. Knowledge and skills in this area are among the "green competences" that will be necessary for functioning in the reality undergoing transformation related to the European Green Deal. Stimulating young people's interest in environmental issues will be beneficial for their further scientific and professional development. Projects implemented in accordance with the principles of non-formal education are a unique opportunity to develop soft skills. They are extremely useful, especially in the professional dimension, but not only. The ability to organize time and work, work in a team and leadership skills are very important competences that are difficult to develop at school or university, and much easier in practice. That is why one of the goals of this project will be to design activities in a way that will enable young people to develop these skills in a safe and friendly environment. Additionally, we want the project to stimulate the creativity of young people. We will achieve this by introducing an artistic element - in the form of creating a model of the Green City - as one of the activities within the youth exchange.

Food and accommodation are provided and paid by the organizer. The travel costs will be calculated on the basis of the European Commission's distance calculator and will be refunded by bank transfer at the exchange rate (in euro €).

Participant Insurance: Due to the complexity of the program, each participant must have full travel and health insurance (medical insurance, which also covers Covid-19), covering both travel and stays from the first to the last day of their return home. The insurance is covered by the participants.

Travel expenses: Travel expenses (from your home town to the place of the course) are reimbursed on presentation of the relevant receipts **up to the maximum amount indicated in the table.** under the Training Course, reimbursement will only be made for travel expenses incurred in accordance with the following rules:

• Travel expenses will only be reimbursed upon presentation of documents proving the amount actually paid: original invoice. Documents must include the date, price, traveler's name,

- destinations, and the receipt must be completely clear.
- Electronic tickets will be refunded only upon receipt of proof of payment (invoice, booking / purchase document printed from the Internet, copy of the credit card stub showing the money transfer for the ticket, confirmation of payment from the Internet) and on presentation of the return boarding pass.
- Remember that the booking document alone is not enough to prove travel expenses. You must also present your boarding passes, bill, proof of payment and a printout from your bank account to confirm the amount paid for the ticket.
- **Keep all travel documents** that you will receive during your trip: boarding passes, receipts, tickets, etc. as we absolutely need them!
- taxi rides no are refundable.

Tasks to be performed:

- -Every country must make a presentation on culture in their country for cultural evenings
- -Every country must make a presentation on environmental habits and ideas for solutions in their country
- -Each country must send proposals for environmental workshops

What to take with you?

- Passport or ID card
- All travel tickets !!! (it is very important to keep all tickets, receipts and boarding passes as we can only refund your travel expenses if you have tickets)
- National snacks, specialty drinks (I am a chef, please note), local music for a cultural evening
- Medicines if you need them (antiallergic pills, painkillers, aspirin, etc.)
