

ERASMUS+ TRAINING COURSE IN SAULKRASTI, LATVIA

Brief Description

Nowadays worldwide tendency of relocating from the villages to the large cities of youth to acquire quality life and prosperity is on the rise. Ultimately this phenomenon creates massive stress for a large number of human beings in the large cities to find reasonable jobs to bear their expenses for accommodations, bills and other basic needs.

To acquiring such goals, human beings ignore the most vital thing, quality and organic food. At the same time fresh and healthy environment as well. This paradigm shift contributing to and generating more polluted cities and unhealthy quality of life.

In addition to the above-mentioned issues, the employment of young people with fewer opportunities is a maximum sweltering one. Youngsters the "EDUCATED UNEMPLOYED' are joining the so-called NEETs (not in employment, education or training). They may be even extra marginalized if their geographic region, gender, ethnicity, social fame, or disability isolates them from the mainstream.

Within the existence of such financial and social traumatic conditions, there is a call for, especially for more youthful people with fewer opportunities, to better prepare them for nowadays's numerous and unpredictable professional pathways and information them the possibility to broaden themselves into successful eco-social entrepreneurs.

Goals and Methods

Eco-employment might be defined as "accountable usage of the sources that conserves the environment, sustains the nicely-being of the local community and consists of interpretation and schooling". We agree that many neighborhood organizations can advantage of selling eco-employment of their regions, especially if they're placed in areas with huge lands and clean water.

The primary purpose of the "Youth NEED/T" project is to deck youth workers with the critical abilities and educational manner to be proficient to contribute to voluntary organisations so that they can support NEET to make the preeminent step, both for ecoemployment or edification. In this regard, the particular aspirations of the project for youth workers are:

- To provide youth workers through precious, non-formal educational instruments which can be vital for reading the authenticity of more youthful NEETs, at the identical time simultaneously allowing younger NEETs in their companies to interchange their potentials into opportunities.
- To recognize the effect of getting young people in a NEET situation and discover neighborhood realities.
- To accumulate about intrusions and styles of assist to early school-leavers, to prevent future NEET situations.

AT THE END OF THE PROJECT EACH PARTICIPANT WILL RECEIVE A YOUTHPASS CERTIFICATE. THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT, PARTICIPANTS WILL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO REVIEW AND IMPROVE THEIR SKILLS IN THE FOLLOWING 8 KEY COMPETENCIES AS DEFINED BY YOUTHPASS:

- 1. MULTILINGUAL COMPETENCE
- 2. PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND LEARNING TO LEARN COMPETENCE
- 3. CITIZENSHIP COMPETENCE
- 4. ENTREPRENEURSHIP COMPETENCE
- 5. CULTURAL AWARENESS AND EXPRESSION COMPETENCE
- 6. **DIGITAL COMPETENCE**
- 7. MATHEMATICAL COMPETENCE AND COMPETENCE IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND ENGINEERING
- 8. LITERACY COMPETENCE




Profile of participants

The project directly targets youth workers, with decision-making capacity and involved in the local and international activities of their organizations sending partners (having an active participation in the preparation phase of this Training Course. They must have experience in working with young people with fewer opportunities, in the use of non-formal education methodologies and in project management, also linked to the topic of the project; they must be motivated to contribute in all phases of the project, to disseminate the results and to stimulate activities with young people, finally, be aware and recognize the problems, needs and expectations of the project and of young Europeans and what opportunities (also for personal / social transformation of their reality) can be used as an answer.

How to get to the venue with public transport

Take bus or minibus 22 from Riga Airport to the city center and get off at the "Autoosta" stop.

Ticket price: 2 EUR / person

From the bus stop "Autoosta" walk about 4 minutes (260 m) to the Central Railway Station "ORIGO".

At the station you buy a ticket to **Saulkrasti**. Trains run every hour, so you do not have to wait long. And the travel time will be about 1 hour.

Attention: Let us know when you depart, so that we are ready to pick you up from the Saulkrasti train station and take you to the project venue.



Travel Reimbursement

International travel expenses can be reimbursed **ONLY** upon presentation of **ALL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS** stating your travel information and costs, namely:

- 1. Boarding passes (For round trip),
- 2. Tickets (Also e-tickets),
- 3. Receipts (In case the tickets are bought by cash),
- 4. Invoices and card payment history (In case the tickets are bought by bank card),
- 5. Payment checks / Bank statements.

Participants are requested to bring with them all mentioned documents, likewise, any other payment bills, checks, tickets and payment prove that they will get during the travel. Regarding way-back tickets and boarding passes, they should be sent by <u>international post service</u> to "YSTREET" in Latvia (example: check-in at airport) or by e-mail (if they were issued through online check-in). **SCANS / PHOTOS / SCREENSHOTS ARE NOT ALLOWED!!!**
